GENERAL ELECTION 2025

The Municipal Election Commission of the Town of Iva, South Carolina announces the General Election for the Town of Iva to be Tuesday, November 4, 2025.

The following offices shall be included in this election.

Mayor for term expiring December 31, 2025.

Council Member from Ward One for the term expiring December 31, 2025.

Council Member from Ward Two for the term expiring December 31, 2025.

Council Member from Ward Three for the term expiring December 31, 2025.

Council Member from Ward Four for the term expiring December 31, 2025.

The polling places are the Iva Civic Center for the Jackson Mill Precinct and the Iva Fire Department for the Iva Precinct. Citizens desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered to vote by October 3, 2025. To register, one must contact the Anderson County Registration and Elections Office. You will be asked to show one of the following photo ID's at your polling place: *ID issued by the S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles; S.C. Voter Registration Card with ID; Federal Military ID; U.S. Passport.*

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices may file at the Iva Town Hall at 204 E. Jackson Street, Iva, S.C. 29655. Books will be open for filing at noon on August 5, 2025 and remain open during regular business hours until noon on August 13, 2025. The filing fee for the Office of Mayor is \$100.00 and the filing fee for the Office of Council Member is \$50.00.

This is a non-partisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot. The Mayor and Council Members shall be qualified electors of the state, county and town and shall have resided within the corporate limits of the Town of Iva for at least six months immediately preceding the date of the election.

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on election day and close at 7:00 p.m. At 7:00 p.m. on said election day, the poll managers will begin examining the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Iva Town Hall, located at 204 E. Jackson Street in Iva, South Carolina. On Thursday, November 6, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. at the Iva Town Hall, the Municipal Elections Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election. Any run-off will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, November 18, 2025.
